Dear Maria and Stefano, Probably you can use the same thing I use to kill secondaries.

Add the function PreTrack() to your detector class before ProcessHits

Inside ProcessHits after you have stored your primaries, do fTrackKillSecondary=KTRUE, if you have a secondary or CurrentParentTrack is not -1.
