Because Lumi can cover 3-8 degree.

Just to prevent misunderstandings let me correct a small typo:

The Lumi covers about 3-8 mrad = 0.17-0.46 degree.

To study effects of the magnetic fields and stuff we even have to simulate lower than 3 mrad,
but i guess we are a special case
