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I have just found the answer on the website

<http://stackoverflow.com/questions/10165693/eclipse-cannot-load-swt-libraries>

and would like to post it here in case other people experience the same problem:

After adding

```
-Djava.library.path=/usr/lib/x86_64-linux-gnu/jni
```

to

```
/etc/eclipse.ini
```

you have to do the following:

Quote:

On Ubuntu 12.04 32 bit enter the command:

```
In -s /usr/lib/jni/libswt-* ~/.swt/lib/linux/x86/
```

And on Ubuntu 12.04 64 bit type:

```
In -s /usr/lib/jni/libswt-* ~/.swt/lib/linux/x86_64/
```

This fixes the loading issue.

However, Ubuntu 12.04 install JavaHL 1.6.x by default, but subclipse requires >=1.7.x

Therefore, I followed the instructions on

<https://plus.google.com/u/0/110836571215849032642/posts/5gecVzxXUpz>
and entered:

```
sudo apt-add-repository ppa:dominik-stadler/subversion-1.7
```

```
sudo apt-get update
```

```
sudo apt-get upgrade
```

```
sudo apt-get install subversion
```

subclipse finally seems to work now.
