there is a option USE\_PATH\_INFO which you can use when running cmake. If the option is true \$PATH is added in the config file.

The default setting is to add the explicit lst of directories.

To use this option pass it on the command line

cmake <source\_dir> -DUSE\_PATH\_INFO=TRUE

Hope this solves your poblem.
