Hello Mohammad,

changing to ROOT6, along with you proposed fix solved the problem. I successfully installed fairsoft\_nov15p5 on my computer.

Now, I run into problems when installing FairRoot 15.11b. First, I get this error when calling CMake:

-- The compiler during the compilation of FairSoft is different from the current one. CMake Error at cmake/modules/CheckCompiler.cmake:64 (Message):

This is seen as an error. If you know that the setting is correct you can silence the error by using the CMake flag -DUSE\_DIFFERENT\_COMPILER=TRUE Call Stack (most recent call first):

-- Configuring incomplete, errors occurred!

When I use the suggested CMake flag, the configuration completes. However, when compiling FairRoot with make, I get this error:
