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Hi,

normally gcc knows where to find the gfortran library because this is a build-in path. In your case the gfortran library is installed at a different location. There are now two different possibilities to solve the problem. Either you install the proper version of gfortran. Then gcc should find the gfortran library during the linking or you define the proper gfortran location in the link command. I would favor the second option because otherwise you have to recompile with the new fortran compiler.

Could you please execute the following command and report the result.
