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Hi all,

I was just playing with EVO and reading its manual... here are some ideas which we could exploit for the upcoming meetings:

It is possible to "call" any H323 hardware device (Polycom, Tandberg, Aethra, etc.) or H323 software clients (Ekiga, Xmeeting, VCON, etc) from within a EVO session. The SIP protocol is also supported by EVO. I tried it out by trying to setup a meeting with a Xmeeting program running on my MAC. It seems to work pretty ok. This means that we can use this option to setup a connection with those who have difficulties using EVO directly. Of course, those with problems should tell us the phone number of their device or IP address of the software client which they are using... But in principle this is do-able... Would that be a reasonable solution??
