I found that when one loads the environment to run PandaRoot, so the SetEnv.sh script or the config.sh, the following lines are printed:

On this machine the

G4LEVELGAMMADATA=/misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/new/transport/geant4/data/PhotonEvaporation

On this machine the

G4RADIOACTIVEDATA=/misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/new/transport/geant4/data/RadiativeDecay

On this machine the

G4LEDDATA=/misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/new/transport/geant4/data/G4EMLOW3.0

On this machine the

NeutronHPCrossSections=/misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/new/transport/geant4/data/G4NDL3.8

On this machine the

G4ELASTICDATA=/misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/new/transport/geant4/data/G4ELASTIC1.1

(at GSI).

But I found also that the directory /misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/new/transport/geant4/data/ does not exist!!!! (and also for the common installations of external packages).

I loaded the "old" external packages, and there the directory /misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/transport/geant4/data/ does exist!!!

What's going on?
