> inside "passive" directory, so in between the common packages  
> - it cannot be touched by us.

The passive directory belongs to pandaroot and not to the  
base classes, so you can change whatever you want.  
It even must belong to panda otherwise cbm and panda must  
use the same pipe, target etc.
