A General question:

How does the RuntimeDB handle multiple reprocessing of the same(!) run?

The following use-case is very common at the moment: I have an MC-data file and want to digitize it several times with different parameter sets to do Detector-Studies. In the reconstruction and in the analysis stages I might also want to try out several sets of settings. Moreover I expect the database to ensure, that when I look at one event for analysis I will get the correct parameters, which have been used for digitization (reco... etc.).
