Hi Andrei,

we know there are several classes above all concerning the vertexes which have not been yet implemented in the merged stt code. We did not import the stt2 vertex classes previously, because we were more focussed on the momentum resolution, geane stuff and so on, but we kept in mind the existence of such classes. Up to now we have not thought so much about the vertexing, but we are open also to the option of reusing Ralph' s classes, which, moreover, fit in the existing stt structure (with some changes, for example they should also be translated into PndStt instead of CbmStt (see new stt repository) according to the conventions).

If you want to try to adapt the old Ralph' s vertex code to the stt you' re welcome!
