Hi Florian,

you are right. The entry /home/kph/sokolov/geant4/bin/Linux-g++ in the PATH cause an error.

Therefore I would suggest to modify the UNIQUE macro as following: MACRO(UNIQUE var_name list)

SET(unique_tmp "")
FOREACH(I \${list})
STRING(REGEX REPLACE "[+]" "\\\\+" I1 \${I})
IF(NOT "\${unique_tmp}" MATCHES "(^|;)\${I1}(;|\$)")
SET(unique_tmp \${unique_tmp} \${I})
ENDIF(NOT "\${unique_tmp}" MATCHES "(^|;)\${I1}(;|\$)")
ENDFOREACH(I)
SET(\${var_name} \${unique_tmp})
ENDMACRO(UNIQUE)

It will screen each + symbol with \ and problem should disappear.

Also I would propose modify the WriteConfigFile.cmake as follow:
