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Hi Mohammad,

I have the following problem with new external packages.

When I run

```
./configure.sh automatic
```

I have the following message

```
The build process for the external packages for the FairRoot Project was started at  
130308_153705
```

```
Could not extract the version of gfortran
```

```
Stop script at this point
```

When I try

```
>gfortran -dumpversion
```

it gives:

```
GNU Fortran 95 (GCC 4.0.2 20051130 (Red Hat 4.0.2-14.EL4))
```

```
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```

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So when I look into /scripts/set\_compiler.sh on the line 20

```
if [ $(gfortran -dumpversion | grep 'GNU Fortran 95 (GCC)' | cut -c 1-3) ];
```

my "gfortran -dumpversion" output mismatch this pattern, since bracket is not closed after GCC.

I am using Scientific Linux 4.

How to proceed?
