Quote: if you have pointers as member variables of your data object (Track, TrackRep or what ever) you should tell rootcint not to stream these pointers by putting "//!" in the header file directly after declaration of these pointers, other wise root will stream them to the file and you will need the libraries to read the root file!

That would of course be a solution, but then the Track object will be of not much use. I can not think about many applications where you need track parameters without having the ability to propagate them.
