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Is it possible that the problem comes from the final exit(0)?

In Torino I have found that in some machine (a few) the exit function could give problems, something like the memory is not dumped correctly in the file. So the analysis goes fine, but when one tries to use some reconstruction macro...they fail. I have found that with the normal exit ".q" it does not produce the same error.

I found this in only one machine, maybe related to its memory, however I am wondering if one could launch in the dashboard something like a root -q instead of using this "brute force" exiting.

I am just trying to guess...no idea on what went wrong in this case.
