Hi

There are external packages for all kind of Debian flavors here at GSI. If you want to know which machine you're using do

```
> echo $OS
```

3.1 means Debian Sarge, whereas 4.0 is Debian Etch. After that do
a

```
> uname -m
```

If the result is x86_64 you're on a 64bit machine, if the result is i686 you're on a 32bit machine. According to the results you have to choose the SIMPATH

```
Sarge32 : /misc/cbmsoft/Sarge32/jul08/fairsoft/
```

```
Sarge64 : /misc/cbmsoft/Sarge64/jul08/fairsoft/
```

```
Etch32  : /misc/cbmsoft/Etch32/jul08/fairsoft/
```

```
Etch64  : /misc/cbmsoft/Etch64/jul08/fairsoft/
```

If you compile PandaRoot for one of these systems you can run it only on that system.
