the svn comments are fine, but the normal developer/user does not read svn usually, only when he finds some troubles.

Maybe then the normal developer should not use the trunk version but the stable version. The trunk version is not thought to be stable all the time. If one uses the trunk version one has to take care at least a little bit.

Quote:you are completely right that one should to use svn comments. And in addition it would be also very helpful to announce "all" changes in the forum with a brief description what has been changed

Here i disagree. First of all you're flooded with thousands of meaningless topics which say "Changed variable B from int to double" if you really require this. I agree that a major change of the code should be made public somewhere that the people are aware of, but definitely not all changes. The other point i want to make is that if people don't write meaningful svn comments they will not write a topic for the forum. It would help much more if you would have a good comment.
