Quote: In this context I have another remark to Mohammad's point 3. I took a look into the pndbase directory and I am surprised that this base directory contains only detector specific data classes. I my point of view a base directory should only contain "base classes", i.e. abstract classes or classes without (more or less) any dependencies, which can be used everywhere. An example would be a general RecoHit class as suggested by Ola. The dectector specific data classes should be defined in directories which are at least one layer below.

pndbase contain only data classes and no functionality, and the abstract classes you mentioned are in base! The idea of pndbase was to collect the whole data classes which should contain no functionality there, may be we should call it panda data or something like this?
