Hi,

I don't think the solution to divide different users into different disks could help us, even because the full disk is due usually to few users, and they are not "equally" distributed in alphabetical order. This could mean that one disk could become full before the other, and the user who needs additional space cannot use the other free disk. And if the community will grow, we will need maybe more disks and then we should move the user under the corresponding disk... not so nice, I think.

Let me remind that the folders in /d/panda0X are created by the users and are not set automatically by the system, so if I need more space, I could create a new dir in a different disk. I know this solution is not so nice, but panda has not yet fixed policies and resources for the computing, even because it is a bit early, therefore I think we have to live for some time with some "precarious" state.
