Hello Mohammad and Florian,

when I tried to run the installation script I have observed the following error message:

scripts/set\_compiler.sh: line 32: [: .: integer expression expected Could not extract the version of gfortran Stop script at this point

Looking in the set\_compiler.sh script I found that among other issues it makes an analysis of the output text of the gfortran -v command. The problem is that I by default use the ru\_RU.utf-8 encoding and the output looks a little bit different of what is expected.

To avoid in the future such an issue I would suggest to include in the text of the set\_compiler.sh script the following lines:

default\_lang=\$(echo \$LANG) LANG=en\_EN.utf-8 in the beginning (to set the needed encoding)

export LANG=\${default\_lang}
at the end (to restore the default encoding)

I checked this correction - it works at least on my computer.
