Quote:Cloning at runtime is helpful if you would like to use a (sub)task/module several times in your application.

Let's assume, one has a (sub)task/module which is responsible for creating a list of data object references based on specific input parameters. Cloning means in this context that one creates a second identical (sub)task but with different input parameters.

I think you don't understand what rootcint and the framework can do. What you requested is already there. For example have a look at eventDisplay.C in the macro/run directory of pandaroot. There you will find an example which shows that you add many times one task with different parameters in the same macro. If I understand you correctly this is exactly what you're are looking for.
