I have problem in running the reconstruction although this macro was working fine, somehow today it is not working. Today I updated everything from SVN. Has there any change been made? Or I'm making some mistakes some where. I set the SIMPATH as

/misc/cbmsoft/Debian3.1/fairsoft/

I tried to run the following macro from pandaroot/macro/fsim/runAll.C but it is giving lots of errors.

If you have compiled pandaroot with a wrong release of the external packages, maybe the best thing to do is to recompile everything from scratch in another directory, with the correct SIMPATH.

The error you give seems to come from a wrong ROOT version.
