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Dear all,
it seems that starting from gcc 4.2.1 new warnings appear in our code:

warning: deprecated conversion from string constant to 'Text_t*'

They come each time we write something like `rtdb->getContainer("PndGeoPassivePar")`, more in general when we write a string directly in our function, instead of defining it as a string and then passing the variable to the code.

The question is: should we care about this? If I have understood well in the more recent releases of gcc this warning becomes an error...
