could you please add the following line in PndLheTrackFitter, so that I can see which numbers are giving problems?

In particular, please add at line 220 (before if (ih==0)):

```
cout << ih << "\t" << track->GetCharge() << "\t" << x << "\t" << y << "\t" << z << "\t" << px <<  
"\t" << py << "\t" << pz << endl;
```

So that I can try to guess what is going wrong at the track when the code is crashing. I have never seen such kind of error.
