You try to run the software on a different linux flavour than it was compiled on. This is normaly a serious error, so we stop the execution at this point.

It seems at GSI they have upgraded the OS, and now your "old" pandaroot installation is not compatible anymore (it should be, but to be safe the compiler gives this error). The suggestion is to compile pandaroot again in a new empty build directory.
