Hi,

I'm trying to compile the latest FairSoft dev branch, which just bumped DDS to version 2.4. However, I got an error when building FairMQ, complaining that "dds_intercom.h" could not be located.

It seems that the new version of DDS will install the header files under a new subdirectory named \$SIMP_PATH/include/DDS, which is different from the previous version.

The bug could be fixed by appending "DDS" to PATH_SUFFIXES when finding the DDS_INCLUDE_DIR in the cmake file "FindDDS.cmake" under in the FairMQ repository.

How and where should I report this bug? Is there a bug reporting service used in FairRoot/FairSoft development?
