libEGPythia6 is a root library can you check if it exist! normally this library is build when root is configured with pythia (which is the case in the external packages), please check also that libPythia6.so exist in \$SIMPATh/generator/lib if not the libEGPythia will not be build!

could it be that you have problems with your fortran compiler?
