Hi Stefano,

this must be a sourceforge problem. The externals defined in the repository are

<https://genfit.svn.sourceforge.net/svnroot/genfit/trunk/core>

<https://vgm.svn.sourceforge.net/svnroot/vgm/tags/v3-06/vgm>

Somehow it looks like sourceforge changed there svn repositories.

If you visit the genfit project page at sourceforge.net and get the information about the svn repository from there you get the following link

<http://svn.code.sf.net/p/genfit/code/trunk>

which is the link you also get as error message. The easiest solution is to change the externals for genfit and vgm in the repository and the problem should be gone.

If you do for example a

svn ls <https://svn.code.sf.net/p/genfit/code/trunk/core>

you see the expected list of files.
