The rules say:

Post the presentation title: via the PANDA publication form (see below) and email [panda-spc@gsi.de](mailto:panda-spc@gsi.de), as early as possible. Attach abstracts 1 week before submission deadline.

Created PANDA Forum topic. Nudge the committee by email [panda-spc@gsi.de](mailto:panda-spc@gsi.de), a tutor will be

conduct a rehearsal one week prior to the conference. Add the finalized presentation. The actual presented talk or poster should be uploaded after the event using the publication form. It will be made public (released) by the SPC. Proceedings are reviewed by the publication committee.

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
