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Dear PandaRooters,

I have tried to install the external packages on my ubuntu 14.10 64 bit machine. When I am running ./configure command in fairsoft_mar15 directory it comes with the following error message.

can you try it manually. Either do

```
wget ftp://ftp.gnu.org/gnu/gsl/gsl-1.16.tar.gz
```

or

```
curl -O -L ftp://ftp.gnu.org/gnu/gsl/gsl-1.16.tar.gz
```

in the basics directory depending if wget or curl is available. If this doesn't work there is a problem with the connection to the ftp server.

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Hi Ajay,

then you have a problem with your network. I tried several times and it always works.

Could it be that you have some proxy settings which are wrong or not set for ftp?

For gsl you can work around the problem, because there are also a http server which can be used

```
curl -O -L http://ftp.gnu.org/gnu/gsl/gsl-1.16.tar.gz
```

But we have some packages which are distributed only via ftp, so you have to find your network problem or download the files to some other machine and then copy them to your computer.

Pythia6 you get from here

```
wget ftp://root.cern.ch/root/pythia6.tar.gz
```

The only other package which is on a ftp server is geant3 which you get with

```
wget ftp://root.cern.ch/root/vmc/geant321+_vmc.1.15a.tar.gz
```

All other packages are downloaded via http or https protocol which should work.

How did you solve the problem?

Your problem now is that you haven't specified a installation directory when running CMake, so the default install directory (/usr/local) is used and you don't have root permissions to write there.

Please rerun CMake with the correct install directory

```
cmake -DCMAKE_INSTALL_PREFIX=<install directory> <Path to FairRoot source>
```
